The summer vegetable season is coming to a close. I still have green tomatoes on the vine. Here are a few recipes featuring green tomatoes that I discovered on the Internet: AllRecipes: "Spicy Green Tomato-Avocado Salad - Celebrate green tomatoes with this all-green salad of lettuce, avocado and a spicy-sweet jalapeno dressing." Food Network: "Green Tomato Pie - Because of their firm texture and tart flavor, green tomatoes are excellent baked in a pie. Dip slices into a sugar mixture and layer with golden raisins, for sweetness."
