Sunny Glen – November 2023 President's Message

October brought us some great weather with trace amounts of precipitation. It might just be a tease for what possibly is yet to come in the next few months as winter fast approaches. The City has worked hard to get the South San Ramon Creek cleared of debris south of Alcosta Blvd. and north of the Golf Course. This will assure a free-flowing creek to handle stormwater runoff.

Winter storm preparations for residents: The City recently sent out a notice to all San Ramon residents within the FEMA flood zone areas. Residents in the flood zone areas are highly encouraged to procure flood insurance. As we all know, the risk of flooding in Sunny Glen is real and could possibly happen again in 2024. It is the responsibility of the property owners and residents to be prepared in advance of a catastrophic flood event. We are working with the City to provide Sunny Glen with sandbags to protect your property where stormwater may enter your living environment. Residents should plan to evacuate ahead of an Atmospheric River, pack a GO BAG with important medications, food, important documents to take with you until the storm passes.

The Clubhouse update for November: The City of San Ramon building permit office has expedited our permit, and we should have it in hand within a few days. Construction will begin thereafter. We are expecting early 2024 completion barring any construction delays.

Annual and Special Assessments: If you have not paid your assessments or made special arrangements with our Treasurer, your time is running out before your account is sent to Collections. You will receive one more demand letter with instructions on paying your assessments. Please don't let your account go to collections. We can work with you on a payment plan.

The Day of the Dead (Spanish: el Día de Muertos or el Día de los Muertos) is a holiday traditionally celebrated on November 1 and 2, It is widely observed in Mexico, where it largely developed, and is also observed in other places, especially by people of Mexican heritage. Although related to the simultaneous Christian remembrances for Hallowtide, it has a much less solemn tone and is portrayed as a holiday of joyful celebration rather than mourning. Some argue that there are Indigenous Mexican or ancient AZTEC influences that account for the custom, and it has become a way to remember those forebearers of Mexican culture. The multi-day holiday involves family and friends gathering to pay respects and to remember friends and family members who have died. These celebrations can take a humorous tone, as celebrants remember funny events and anecdotes about the departed.
