As you read this, it is only a few weeks until we reopen Sunny Glen Library. I thought I would review how to use and enjoy your library.

The library includes books, CDs, DVDs, magazines, and jigsaw puzzles. You are welcome to borrow any item. Simply take what interests you and return it to the basket or the shelves below when you are finished with it. There is no time limit. The library volunteers will replace the item on the correct shelf.

Books are separated into several general categories and arranged by the author's last name. Biographies (arranged by the subject's last name), Inspiration & Religion, Non-Fiction, Mysteries, Spies and Intrigue, Romance, Novels, Large Print, and Local History/Local Authors.

Jigsaw puzzles have some special rules. 1. All puzzles are checked that they are complete. 2. Puzzles are in a closed plastic bag in their box to prevent pieces from getting lost in storage. 3. Please completely disassemble the puzzle before returning it, so the next user has the joy of putting it together. 4. If you borrow a puzzle that has pieces missing, simply put it in your recycling. Do not return it to the library.

All items in the Sunny Glen Library have been donated by residents. Items to be donated must be clean, in good condition, and of general interest. We have limited space, so we cannot accept oversized books or a large number of items.

I look forward to opening our library. See you there!
