Winter Storms:

Early storms being called Atmospheric Rivers have started in Northern California and parts of the Bay Area. Sunny Glen came through these last storms without incident; however Sunny Glen is prone to flooding due to our proximity to South San Ramon Creek, and we all need to remain vigilant in preparing our property and ourselves for the possibility of flooding this winter. It is most important to take care of ourselves by preparing an evacuation plan in case the need arises. Prepare a GO BAG with clothing, medications, important documents, phone numbers of relatives, credit cards, flashlights, cell phone & charge cables, etc. Plan on having enough to stay away from your home for several days if needed. Leave your prepared GO BAG by your front door. Plan on taking your car with you or moving your car to high ground on Tangerine Street. There is a city padlock on the emergency gate at the end of Craydon Cir. The City of San Ramon Public Works, San Ramon Police and San Ramon Valley Fire will be able to open the gate in case of an emergency. If your property sits in the FEMA Flood Zone, it's advisable to have flood insurance. Do not drive through flood waters, walk in flooded streets, or walk on sidewalks. Manhole and utility covers will be lifted out of place by flood waters and create a large hole that you could fall into. Do not try to clear street drains of debris as they will not drain water in a flood until the water in the South San Ramon Creek recedes below the street drain outlets. The vegetation and debris have been cleared from the creek banks by city crews. The city has provided sandbags for our residents on Craydon Circle under the blue tarp.

Feeding Wildlife in our community: This unlawful practice persists in our community!

There appears that for the last several weeks and now months, people are feeding wildlife with bread and fruit pieces. We are finding the bread piles in neighbor's yards and on some of our dead-end streets within Sunny Glen. This is dangerous for the wildlife and it's not part of their natural diet. It's against the law to feed wildlife and unkind to our neighbors who must pick up the mess. This seems to happen after bread distributions on Sundays at the Clubhouse. Please STOP this practice immediately! Let native wildlife stay wild. Although well intentioned, feeding wildlife disrupts natural behaviors and can reduce long-term survival.

Next Community Board meeting is **7pm Wednesday, December 4, 2024** at the Clubhouse, 9000 Craydon Circle.

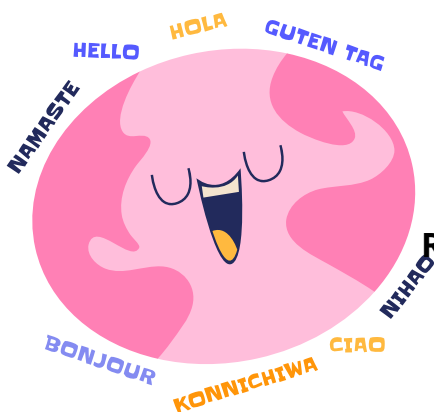

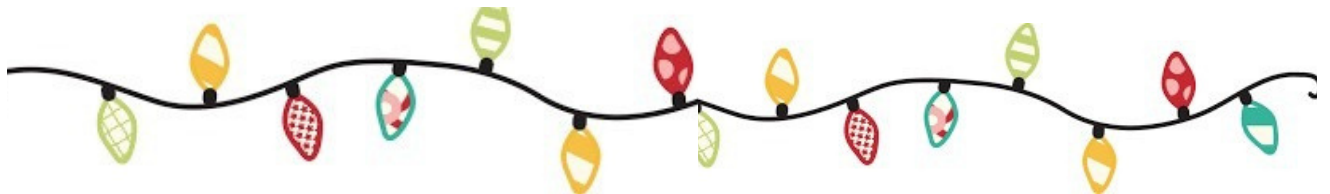


LIBRARY NEWS - JOYCE GUNN

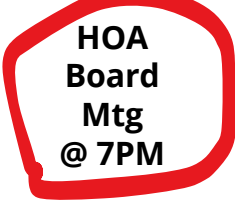
