French Drain at the Clubhouse:

There will be three test samples of paint and trim color painted on the front wall for community input. The painting will be done between rain drops and finished by the end of May or sooner.

RV Parking:

There are three spaces open for RV storage. Two spaces have been vacant for over a year and the board has approved opening it up to people outside of Sunny Glen. As a Sunny Glen resident you may secure a space for a family member not living in Sunny Glen. Sunny Glen residents are charged for space rentals at \$950.00 per year. Outside residents will be charged \$1500.00 per year.

Piano, Large Screen TV:

The piano in the Clubhouse Hall has been tuned. It was donated by a gracious anonymous donor. We hope to hear our community members playing it soon. A drive is under way to raise funds to purchase a large 100" TV for the Clubhouse Hall. It's about a \$1600 purchase and will be funded by donations. We have a generous \$500 pledge from a resident to start things off. There will be a crafts fair at the clubhouse and proceeds from table rentals from participants will go towards the TV.

MONTHLY BOOK CLUB


