Next Community Board meeting is **7pm Wednesday November 5, 2025**, at the Clubhouse, 9000 Craydon Circle.

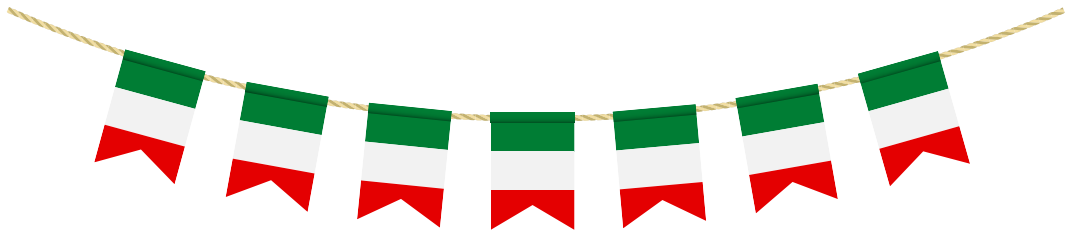

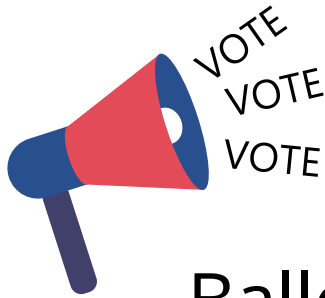

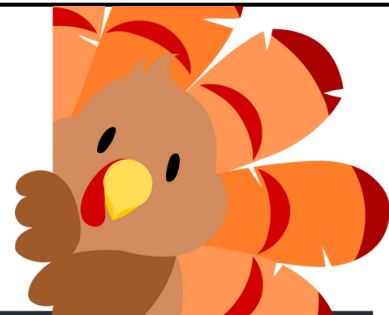
