## PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE:

### CC&R & Bylaws Voting:

The rewriting of our CC&R's and Bylaws has been a three-year adventure in patience, learning current California HOA Laws, and how they apply to Sunny Glen Senior Community. Our current CC&R's and Bylaws are out of date with newer California laws rendering them nearly obsolete. The last thing to be done in bringing them into current compliance is voting on the packet that all the property owners were sent. Your ballot was in the packet that you received. After you fill out the ballot, place it in the long mailing envelope and sign the front of the mailing envelope. Place it in the mail or drop off at the clubhouse in either of the two black mailboxes or in the mail slot of the office door by 5:00pm, Wednesday, December 31<sup>st</sup>.

### Fircrest Lane Parking:

On November 20<sup>th</sup>, members of our community met with the San Ramon TAC (Transportation Advisory Committee) to discuss the parking situation along Fircrest Lane in front of San Ramon Ivy Park Assisted Care Facility. Two very important things happened at this meeting; #1 Sunny Glen community members present were able to voice their concerns to the TAC committee. #2 Chris Weeks Division Manager of the Transportation Department and PJ Dhoot, Associate Transportation Planner along with other City of San Ramon staff members were present to hear the concerns. This was an opportunity to discuss the issues at a formal City meeting. Now we wait to hear from the City of all the findings they have recorded to date. It's important to keep in mind that by restricting parking on Fircrest Lane we run the risk of moving the traffic onto the residential side streets. Finding the right solution to this difficult problem will take some thoughtful considerations of all the traffic calming tools available. We will stay in touch and follow up with the city in 2026.

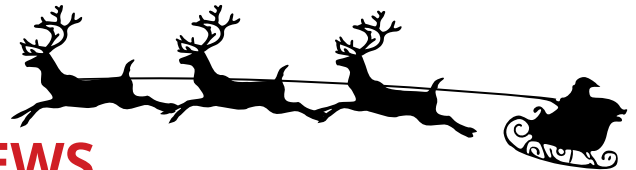

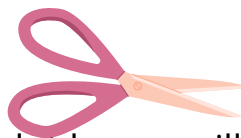

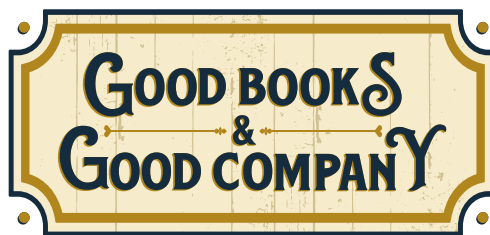
Scrapbooking, paper crafts, crochet, puppet making.....whatever your craft!

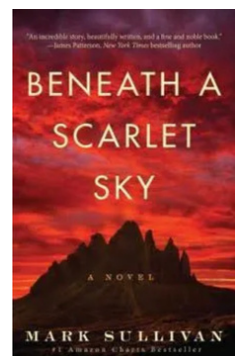
