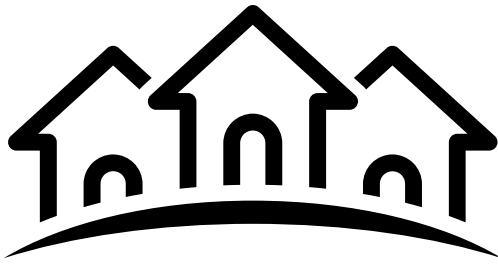


2025 CHRISTMAS CAROLERS

CALLING ALL CRAFTERS

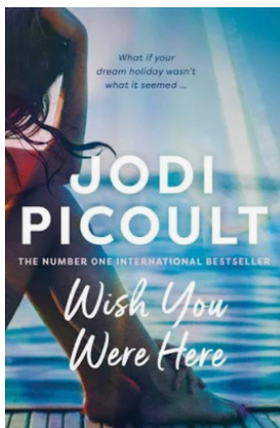


The clubhouse will be open Saturday, January 3, 2026, **ALL DAY** for crafting!
